

(1) Financial assistance to disaster affected staff at Uttarakhand.

CMD assured that the administration will take care of the hardships of the employees and the PSU will extend help to the employees. However, he felt that the BSNL staff should come forward to contribute to the "Prime Minister Relief Fund." He appreciated the role of union for approaching the MOC for fund for purchase of materials so that the services are restored at the earliest.

(2) Procedure/Rule for Pension and Terminal benefits to DR BSNL staff on superannuation:- The union stated that this strike demand is still not resolved CMD informed that the finance wing in corporate office is on the Job. The union urged that the staff side representatives be included in the committee settlement expedited.

(3) Wage erosion of employees entering in PSU on 01-01-2007 or thereafter:- The CMD has asked for the case urgently for further action.

(4) Revision in allowances on 78.2% IDA:- Union pointed out that as per agreement allowances viz HRA skill upgradation, Medical will continue on 68.8% upto 31-03-2013 and other allowances should be revised as per 78.2% IDA. The CMD told there will no problem in settlement of minor allowances.

(5) Closure of Telegraph offices:- The union leaders expressed their pains over the press statement of Sr.GM (TS) that expenditures are more and revenue less in Telegraphs as such it is being closed. The statement is not factual as expenditures are not booked in correct heads of account. However, it appears the Management is keen that Telegraph Service should go with disrepute CMD lastly told the BSNL alone is providing vital service at Uttarakhand which is in grief due to disaster.
