<u>Subject:-</u> Eligibility of Candidates possessing higher qualification to appear in JE LICE – req.

Respected Madam,

Vide para (4)of Corporate office letter No.-211-13/2018-Estt, dt-10-09-2018 it has been clarified that the candidates possessing higher qualifications directly without 10th and 10+2 standard are not eligible to appear in the LICE for JE (TTA) promotion. Apparently the said clarification is not in accordance with the provisions prescribed in the concerned R/R.

Apart from above it is stated that the education system has undergone changes and many open and long distance universities have opened duly recognised by UGC and the state Govt. The integrated Courses have also been introduced. These are to fulfill the aspirations of the people to acquire higher qualification without passing matriculation/10+2 standards. Such acquired degrees are recognised by the Govts. In this situation it is strongly felt, why the BSNL is considering the higher qualification, Graduation, so obtained as stigma for LICE eligibility and insisting for aged old pattern. The higher qualification candidates be encouraged and not discouraged. The R/R of JE LICE can be modified and changed as per new scenario.

We, therefore, request you to please get the matter considered in real perspective instead of sticking to the old pattern of 10+2 or intermediate.
