It is to bring to your kind notice that 230 qualified candidates of various JTO LICE are waiting since last 4 years to get the final results, training and posting there on. The candidates are qualified in VY-2014-15, VY-2015-16, VY-2016-17 and VY-2017-18.


Much earlier the BSNL headquarter issued an order vide No-6-1/Gen/2016/Estt-IV dated 4th may 2017 to carry forward all the unfilled vacancy for next year LICE and it was implemented through out the country. In between some litigation for reservation raised and the final result was kept pending. Again corporate office issued an order dated 17.05.18 based on the Hon'ble Supreme Court verdict in SLP (civil)-30621/2011 and directed to deal all the promotional cases related to reservations accordingly. The Hariyana circle was also having some pending cases and they resolved the issue according to order dated 17.05.2018, the result was finalized and the qualified candidates were sent in training but similar treatment was not adopted by Punjab circle and the candidates were left on their fate.

Sir, really it is much painfull at the part of qualified candidates who are suffering for no fault at their part. All the qualified candidates are young, well educated, energetic and they have qualified the LICE also, actually they are assets for the BSNL.

Under the circumstances only your kind intervention can save the carrier of youngsters who are feeling now snubbed and demoralized which may pull them towards disconcerting. We therefore employe upon you to kindly evolve a sturdy mechanism through any arbitration to resolve the issue so that carrier of 230 younger generation may be protected.
