

Let us remember and commemorate 19th September, 1968 one day strike. The Central Govt Employees demanded “Need based minimum wage” and organized glorious one day strike on the said date. Thousands of workers were victimized and dismissed and taken back on duty only after prolonged period. The leaders of the struggle were sent to jails and suffered enormously. The Posts and Telegraphs workers and the then leaders viz late D. Gnaih, O.P. Gupta played a leading role in the struggle.

Victimisations ended only when the Janta Party formed the Govt in 1977 and Shri George Fernandez took over as Minister for communications.
