<u>Subject:-</u> Medical facility to the working employees in BSNL – resolution in AIC.

Sir,

The 6<sup>th</sup> All India conference, held at Ranchi, deliberated at length the existing Medical facilities to the employees and adopted a resolution thereon. A copy of the same is enclosed for appropriate consideration.

It is stated that the medical facilities are extended to the employees as welfare measure in all PSUs and Govt Departments. BSNL MRS facility was evolved in 2003/2004 in this regard, However, the same has been curtailed to large extent due to obvious factor and it is now very nominal. A sizeable retired employees have migrated to the CGHs scheme and in the process financial burden on BSNL has considerably decreased. The Corporate office during crisis negotiated with a insurance Company and has evolved a Medical facility scheme (Group Insurance Health Scheme) in which the employees are required to pay the entire amount of the premiums so fixed. You will agree, Sir, it cannot be taken as welfare measure on the part of PSU. We hold the view that the company should pay the entire amount of premium as welfare measure. The expenditure in this respect has already reduced due to migration of retired and working personnel to CGHS and GIH scheme respectively.

Kindly, therefore, get the matter considered in real perspective to pay the entire cost of premiums.
