Sir,


Vide our letter No.-TF-58/3, dt-20-12-2019 (copy enclosed) we have drawn your kind attention on the issue of confusion in Vigilance clearance due to contradictory orders issued in CVO BSNL letter No.-22-22/2017/General/Vol-I, dt-13-12-2019. Till date the matter has not been resolved.

It is once again stated that the VRS optees may face avoidable hardships and sufferings if the orders issued by CVO orders issued by CVO are either not withdrawn or modified. We hold the view that the Vigilance cell cannot override the provision of Rule 69 of CCS Pension Rule 1972 as well as BSNL HQR orders contained in letter No.-1-15/2019-PAT (BSNL), dt-04-11-2019 which has reportedly got concurrence of the DOT.

Kindly, therefore, get the matter settled at the earliest.
