- Hindi Pakhwada is being celebrated at all offices of BSNL (BSNLCO, Circle, BA and OA) and always there is active participation from all level Officers/Staff. To make good use of this platform it is requested to include below noted topics in essay writing competition to be held during Hindi Pakhwada 2024 (from 01.09.2024 to 14.09.2024) at Circle/BA/ OA level celebrations

“Culture of Integrity for Nation's Prosperity”


