**Subject:-** Organisation Transformation in strategic areas of BSNL - Meeting - reg.

Respected Sir,

Kindly recall the discussions held on 24<sup>th</sup> May, 2024 on the subject. While the NFTE -BSNL appreciates the concerns and anxieties of the BSNL management to accelerate the steps to place the PSU at the profit position, we have apprehensions with cogent reasons. It would have been better to hold discussions with Unions/Associations before payment of Rs. 132 crores to BCG.

It will be appropriate to state that from the year 2014 we are urging for launching of 4G/5G services akin to private companies but it could not materialize till date. Undoubtedly this has adversely affected the BSNL's growth and revenue due to obvious factors. Even today we are severely perturbed as 1.8 crores customers have migrated from us due to failure to provide 4G/5G services to customers. We firmly hold the view unless 4G/5G services are available placing the entity in profit will be very difficult task. We do not know when BSNL will do this to the satisfaction of the customers.

Apart from above the present frustrations of work force cannot be ignored as almost 2/3<sup>rd</sup> existing non-executive employees are stagnating from years together. This vital issue has to be resolved sooner the better for the services. You may recall that in our All India Conference held at Ranchi, we pointedly urged that the issues within the domain of management be resolved to which you had indicated positive response. Till date the grievances remain as before. In this connection we have submitted series of representations for consideration but no headway is noticed.

Under the circumstances we again urge upon you, Sir, to very kindly consider the issues dispassionately in larger interest of the giant organisation, BSNL, and its workforce. We are afraid without resolution of the issues relating to employees attaining target will be difficult task if not impossible.
